

Certificate of Safety Training (CoST) CONTINUED COMPETENCE



The Certificate of Safety Training – Continued Competence course is aimed at Seafarers that hold an existing CoST, and meet the mandatory onboard training and experience who require continued competency under the STCW convention.

The CoST – Continued Competence course is Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) approved and is made up of two short courses as follows:

- Personal Survival Techniques (STCW Reg VI/1 Code A-VI/1 Table A-VI/1-1)
- Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting (Basic) (STCW Reg VI/1 Code A-VI/1 Table A-VI/1-2)

1 Day

Certification

On successful completion of the course, students will receive an AMSA recognised Statement Certificate.

Pre-requisites

- ✓ AMSA endorsed STCW Certificate of Safety Training

Validity

Five years
