

MROVCP

Marine Radio Operator's VHF Certificate of Proficiency



Under the *Radio Communications Act 1992*, the installation and operation of marine radio equipment aboard any Australian Vessel must be authorised by a licence. In the case of marine VHF equipment on board an Australian vessel this is authorised by a maritime ship station class licence.

As a minimum, under the above licence conditions, all operators of marine VHF equipment are required to possess the Marine Radio Operators VHF Certificate of Proficiency (MROVCP) as issued by the Office of Maritime Communications (OMC).

The VHF course runs over one day and covers VHF communications, radio equipment, GMDSS operation and procedures and VHF procedures and regulations.

Certification

Upon successful completion of the MROVCP course, students will receive the Marine Radio Operators VHF certificate of Proficiency licence form Office of Maritime Communications (Australian Maritime College).

Validity

The MROVCP licence certificate does not expire.

The MROVCP course is run upon request for a minimum of one student at AMI, located at 61 Quill Way, Henderson WA. Please contact reception if you would like to book a course.
