Master <24M Near Coastal

(Previously known as Master Class 5)

MAR30913 Certificate III in Maritime Operations (Master up to 24m Near Coastal)



AMI is now offering the Master up to 24m Near Coastal in conjunction with North Regional TAFE (RTO#52788)

This **4-week, full-time** course is designed to provide students with knowledge, skills and competencies, which qualify them to:

- a) Command a commercial vessel <24 m long in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ);
- b) Act as Chief Mate or deck watchkeeper on a vessel <35 m long in the EEZ;
- c) Act as Chief Mate or deck watchkeeper on a vessel <80m long in inshore waters

Certification

On successful completion of the full course, students will receive a qualification for MAR30913 Certificate III in Maritime Operations (Master up to 24m Near Coastal) from North Regional TAFE. This qualification meets AMSA requirements for Master < 24m Near Coastal Certificate of Competency.

Please note student are required to have the required amount of sea service before they can seek certification from AMSA for the Master <24m Certificate of Competency.

- ✚ MARB004 Perform routine maintenance on a vessel up to 24 metres
- ✚ MARB005 Slip or dock a vessel and maintain hull on a vessel up to 80 metres
- ✚ MARH003 Manage and maintain a navigational watch on board vessels up to 80 metres
- ✚ MARH004 Plan and navigate a passage for a vessel up to 80 metres
- ✚ MARH005 Use wheelhouse equipment for safe navigation
- ✚ MARI002 Observe regulations to ensure safe operation of a vessel up to 80 metres
- ✚ MARJ002 Monitor environmental management on a vessel
- ✚ MARK002 Manoeuvre a vessel up to 24 metres within near coastal waters
- ✚ MARN003 Perform seamanship operations on board a vessel up to 24 metres
- ✚ MARF001 Apply basic survival skills in the event of vessel abandonment
- ✚ MARF002 Follow procedures to minimise and fight fires on board a vessel
- ✚ MARF004 Meet work health and safety requirements
- ✚ MARF005 Survive at sea using survival craft

Pre-requisites

- ✓ Apply First Aid - certificate identify HLTAID003 Provide first aid

Hold a valid Senior First Aid Certificate (or equivalent) issued from a nationally registered RTO, showing the following units of competency:

HTLAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

HTLAID002 Provide basic emergency life support

HTLAID003 Provide first aid

Short courses

- ✓ Elements of Shipboard Safety
- ✓ Marine radio (Long Range Operators Certificate of Proficiency)

Short courses are not included in the four weeks of study. Both short courses are offered before and after the Master <24m course.

Validity

The Certificate of Competency is valid for five (5) years and requires to be revalidated with the regulator, prior to expiry.

The course is run regularly (approx. three time per year) at AMI, located at 61 Quill Way, Henderson WA.
