

Confined Space Entry



This **two day Confined Space Entry** course is aimed at those who are required to work in or around confined spaces in the workplace.

The course will include, identifying hazards, work procedures and instructions for the task, applying for permit, accessing and installing equipment, performing work in an enclosed space, wearing and using breathing apparatus, gas testing atmospheres and cleaning up the work area.

There are no pre-requisite units for this course. However it is recommended that participants are not claustrophobic.

As a result of course, students will be able to:

- ✚ Assess confined space for entry
- ✚ Use safety equipment and clothing
- ✚ Control confined space entry
- ✚ Conclude confined space operations
- ✚ Hazards associated with confined space entry, hazard identification and risk
- ✚ Identify the site/enterprise's specific incident response and rescue requirements
- ✚ Identify the permit to work system and the limitations and conditions of the issued permit and authorisation requirements

Certification

- ✚ After successful completion of this course the candidate will be issued a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment for the *MSAPMPER205C Enter a Confined Space* unit of competency.
