

# Gas Test Atmospheres



This **half day** course is aimed at those who are required to carry out gas testing of an atmosphere prior to entering a specific area or workspace.

This Gas Test Atmosphere course provides participants with the necessary knowledge and skills required to safely use, operate and interpret gas testing equipment.

There are no pre-requisite units for this course. However it is recommended that participants are not claustrophobic.

As a result of this course, participants will be able to:

- ✚ Determine type of gas/atmosphere to be tested
- ✚ Identify hazards from possible atmosphere contaminants
- ✚ Use gas test equipment
- ✚ Interpret and report readings
- ✚ Clean and maintain gas testing equipment
- ✚ Inspect and fault find monitoring equipment
- ✚ Maintain records of tests

### **Certification**

- ✚ After successful completion of this course the candidate will be issued a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment for the *MSAPMOHS217A Gas Test Atmospheres* unit of competency.
