

Hazardous Substances Procedures



This **half day**, non-accredited Hazardous Substance training provides participants with the skills and knowledge to handle hazardous substances, including identifying requirements for working with them, confirming site incident procedures and selecting safe handling techniques.

The topics covered in this course are:

- ✚ Requirements for working with dangerous goods/hazardous substances
 - Legislation, standards, codes of practice
 - Material safety data sheets, labelling, placards and signage, registers
 - Classes and characteristics of goods and substances
- ✚ Site incident procedures
 - Incident reporting
 - Safety and environmental requirements
 - Emergency equipment and processes
 - Dangerous goods/hazardous substances manifests
- ✚ Handling techniques
 - Suitable handling and shifting techniques and procedures
 - Storage, separation and segregation
 - Process for unidentified goods/substances and safe disposal

This course is designed for anyone working in the transport, warehousing, distribution and storage industries that are required to handle hazardous substances.

Certification

Upon completion of this course, students will be presented with a Certificate of Attainment for Hazardous Substances Procedures.
