

Lock Out / Tag Out Operations



This **half day** non-accredited Lock Out / Tag Out safety course covers general principles of isolation procedures, key steps to Lock Out / Tag Out of equipment, restrictive devices, group Lock Out / Tag Out, control of multiple energy sources, electrical equipment, mechanical equipment and key steps to restarting equipment.

Lock Out / Tag Out training shall enable participants to recognize energy hazards associated with each type of machinery, piece of equipment, or process, and when the machinery, equipment, or process must be locked out.

The course focuses on the safe work practices and procedures necessary to prevent accidents caused by unexpected movement of machinery and hazardous energy sources.

Lock Out / Tag Out and Isolation procedures are at the core of all industrial, mining and oil and gas companies' safety management procedures.

Being familiar with the systems and equipment used for Lock Out / Tag Out are crucial in keeping those around you and yourself safe.

Certification

Upon completion of this course, students will be presented with a Certificate of Attainment for Lock Out / Tag Out Operations.
