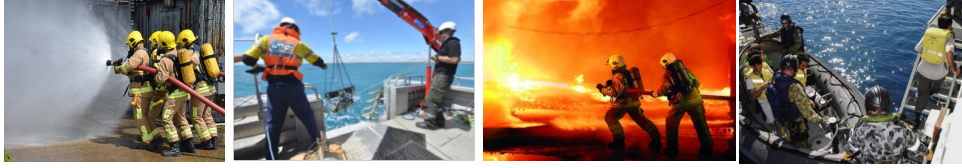


Offshore Incident Response Team Member



This **9 day** course is designed to provide participants with the basic skills and knowledge to respond as part of a team to offshore emergencies. This course is aimed at people working in offshore operations. The training will include extinguishing fires, donning PPE and emergency rescue skills.

Certification
